



BACKGROUND

The Kenya Nuclear Electricity Board (KNEB) is a State Corporation wholly owned by the Government of Kenya. KNEB is established under Legal Notice No. 131 of 2012 and charged with the responsibility of fast-tracking and implementing Kenya's Nuclear Power Programme, in line with the Kenya's Vision 2030 development blueprint.

KNEB's core mandate is to promote and expedite the development of nuclear electricity generation in Kenya through the nuclear power programme by formulating the requisite nuclear policies, strategies and legislation; undertaking public education and awareness; identifying suitable sites for the construction of Nuclear Power Plants and developing human resource capacity for the programme.

The mission of the organization is to promote safe and secure application of nuclear technology for sustainable electricity generation and distribution in Kenya.

YOUTH INTERNSHIP OBJECTIVE

The objective of the KNEB Internship Program is to provide the youth with an opportunity for on the Job training and experience and to develop their ability to successfully take up employment opportunities in all sectors of the economy. KNEB invites suitably qualified and interested candidates who have completed their university /college education to apply for internships for a minimum period of 3 months and a maximum period of 6 months effective July, 2018.

5. Individual performance transcripts

7. Copy of PIN certificate
8. Two (2) colored passport size photos
9. Evidence of NSSF membership
10. Evidence of NHIF membership

Note that a valid copy of student accident cover will be required when starting the internship.
